

#### Harry Houdini was born in 1874.

He was probably the greatest magician and escape artist in the world. He started doing magic when he was 17. At first he did simple magic tricks using playing cards and a wand, but he didn't have much success. Houdini didn't give up. In 1898, Houdini created his famous Challenge Act, which involved escaping from police handcuffs. He then continued to do more difficult acts using ropes, chains and locks. In his most famous acts, he managed to escape from a paper bag without tearing it, and even from a strait-jacket while hanging upside down.

Charlie Chaplin, the clown who made so many people laugh, was born in London in 1889. He started his acting career in the London theatre before going to America in 1913. He quickly became a success and at the age of twenty-five he directed his first movie. He created the tramp character and became very famous. In fact, Charlie used the tramp character with his bowler hat and cane to become one of the most famous clowns in history.
